

Qualification

All students seeking to enroll in any one of our Institute's programs must be in possession of either a high school diploma, matric certificate, or GED equivalent.

Attendance

All students are required to attend a minimum of 80% of their classes. Since class time is very limited, this policy will be strictly enforced. Failure to meet this requirement may result in the student having to repeat, and pay again for the term. Should a student fail to meet this requirement due to illness or employment obligations, then a signed medical/ doctor's note, or a signed letter from the student's employer must be submitted to the Registrar's office in a timely manner.

Students will be marked absent should they miss the first 20 minutes of their class. Three late classes equal one day's absence. Fuzion Bible Institute subscribes to the highest Christian standards, and we expect our students to also reflect high moral and spiritual standards of life. We endeavor to provide leadership by example. All students are required to maintain a high level of integrity and accountability.

Graduation Requirements

ACADEMIC HONOURS

Cum Laude, meaning "with praise."
This honor is typically awarded to graduates if overall percentage is 85-89%.

Magna Cum Laude, meaning "with great praise."
This honor is typically awarded to graduates if overall percentage is 90-95%

Summa Cum Laude, meaning "with highest praise."
This honor is typically awarded to graduates if overall percentage is 96-100%

Student Fees

When we think of good stewardship, we think of how we manage our finances and our faithfulness in paying God's tithes and offerings. But it's much more than that. In fact, it's more than just the management of our time, our possessions, our environment, or our health. Stewardship is our obedient witness to God's sovereignty. It's what motivates the follower of Christ to move into action, doing deeds that manifest his belief in Him. Paul's stewardship involved proclaiming that which was entrusted to him—the gospel truth.

Stewardship defines our practical obedience in the administration of everything under our control, everything entrusted to us. It is the consecration of one's self and possessions to God's service. Stewardship acknowledges in practice that we do not have the right of control over ourselves or our property—God has that control. It means as stewards of God we are managers of that which belongs to God, and we are under His constant authority as we administer His affairs. Faithful stewardship means that we fully acknowledge we are not our own but belong to Christ, the Lord, who gave Himself for us.

The ultimate question, then, is this: Am I the lord of my life, or is Christ the Lord of my life? In essence, stewardship expresses our total obedience to God and our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

PLEASE NOTE

The Registration and Graduation Fees (R1,000) are non-refundable. It is the student's responsibility to attend the graduation ceremony; if they cannot attend, the certificate will be mailed to them.

Financial Policy

Financial responsibility is an important part of spiritual growth and maturity.

All students will be billed at the beginning of each term for the entire term. Students will receive monthly updates or reminders to pay tuition. Each student is responsible for checking their tuition status.

For students who choose to pay monthly, tuition is due on the first calendar day of each month. Students must pay the full monthly tuition amount starting at enrollment and continue through October 30th, 2024 (4 monthly payments each term, 8 monthly payments total).

The tuition and fee amounts are divided evenly over this period of time. It is not related to the number of class days in each month. Regular, monthly tuition payments will continue through vacations and breaks during the school year.

There is a grace period until the 10th of each month for late payments. Any student who has not paid the full month's tuition by the 10th of the month will receive an email reminder. Please contact an Assistant Dean as soon as possible about this matter. If the tuition for the calendar month is not paid in full by the 10th of that month, the student must turn in his/her lanyard and ID to Student Services.

Students may then request a temporary badge and continue to attend classes on any school days up until the 20th of that month. This is how their attendance will be counted if they are reinstated as students. If the monthly tuition hasn't been paid by the 20th of the month, the student will be dismissed.

If tuition is paid before this final deadline, the student is reinstated, and their lanyard and ID will be returned.

Students with unpaid financial obligations (including student Ministry Experience payments) will not receive a certificate, nor will they be able to participate in the graduation ceremonies. If late tuition and fees are paid in full after the conclusion of the school year a certificate will be issued and mailed to the student. Students with unpaid tuition may not return to Fuzion until it has been paid.



REFUND POLICY

Students who submit a withdrawal form, signed by the Director, will be granted a tuition refund if submitted within 14 days of the commencement of the school year. After the 14 days no refund will be granted.
